The venue is the Puamana Clubhouse Gazebo.

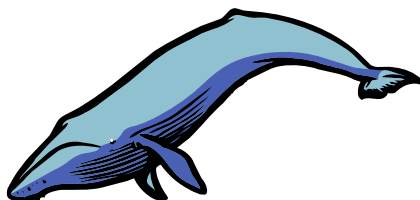
